Configuring the Connection

Open the “Settings” app on your Android device.

Select “Wi-Fi” from the list of options.

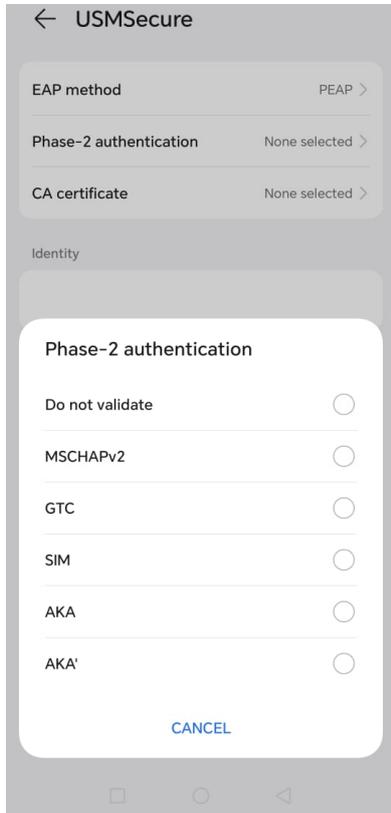
Forget the current WiFi you connected to then connect back to the USMSecure.

CA certificate: Trust on first use / Do not validate

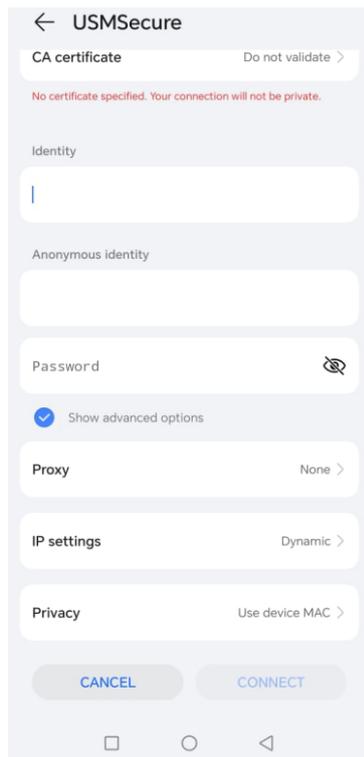

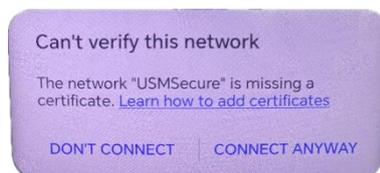
